



SCHOOL CALENDAR 2026/2027

TERM 1: School year begins on Thursday, 27th August 2026

- Halloween Midterm: Monday 26th October 2026 - Friday 30th October 2026 (*inclusive*). Reopen Monday 2nd November 2026.
- Parent/Teacher Meeting 18th & 19th November 2026.
EARLY CLOSURE: Infants finish at 1.15pm 1st – 6th finish at 1.20pm – 1.30pm.
- **Christmas Holidays:** Closing Tuesday 22nd December 2026 (*closing times to be communicated in advance*) – Tuesday 5th January 2027 (*inclusive*).

TERM 2: Return to School Wednesday, 6th January 2027 as normal.

- Closed Monday 1st February 2027 (*Bank Holiday*).
- February Midterm: 18th – 19th February (*2 days only*) – reopen Monday 22nd February 2027.
- Closed Wednesday 17th March 2027 (*St. Patrick's Day*) Re-open Thursday 18th March 2027.
- **Easter Holidays:** Closing Friday 19th March 2027 - (*closing times to be communicated in advance*) – Friday 2nd April 2027 (*inclusive*). Reopen Monday 5th April 2027.

TERM 3: Return to school Monday, 5th April 2027 as normal.

- Closed Monday 3rd May 2027 – Friday 7th May 2027 (*inclusive*) Reopen Monday 10th May 2027.
- Closed Monday 7th June 2027 (*Bank Holiday*). School reopens Tuesday 8th June 2027.
- **Summer Holidays:** Closing Friday 25th June 2027 (*closing times to be communicated in advance*)

NOTE: There will be 3 staff meetings (one per term (will be communicated in advance))

NOTE: There will also be New Primary Curriculum closure days (will be communicated in advance)

Education Welfare Act 2000 – Under the terms of the Education (Welfare) Act 2000 a school is obliged to report to the **National Education Welfare Board** every time a student has reached 20 days absence cumulatively. It is necessary for us to maintain a record of attendance for each child registered at the school. The reasons for non-attendance must also be recorded. In this regard, if your child is absent or needs to leave early from school, please ensure that you provide a **NOTE** on **Aladdin Connect** giving the reason.
