FREE ANTI-DISCRIMINATION TRAINING WORKSHOP

Sport Against Racism Ireland has received funding from the UEFA Foundation for Children, the Department of Children, Equality, Disability, Integration and Youth, and the adidas Foundation to travel around the country delivering a free anti-discrimination sports workshop to schools and youth groups.





Addressing issues such as racism, sexism, homophobia and disabilities the workshop is led by SARI youth coaches from diverse ethnic minority backgrounds. The workshop comprises ball games and exercises with built in awareness of what it means to discriminate on and off the pitch.

The workshop lasts 75 minutes and is delivered on the school playing field, in the playground or - depending on weather and availability - in the gym or hall. We can cater for about 30 participants in each session and up to three sessions per day.

In the days following the workshop participants are asked to complete a questionnaire under the supervision of their teacher reflecting on what they have learnt from the workshop.

The workshop is delivered free of charge and is supported by the Ireland Against Racism Fund, the UEFA Foundation for Children and the adidas Foundation.
